The IB develops inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through education that builds intercultural understanding and respect.


IB Mission Statement



There are 157 IB Diploma Programme school in the world. The IB DP in English corresponds to the Finnish upper secondary school.

The IB Diploma enables you to apply into universities in Finland and abroad.

In the IB DP you can specialise in the subjects you are interested in.



Preparatory year as pre-DP year is similar to the first year in the Finnish upper secondary school except that it is studied in English.

During the pre-DP year your English skills will develop and you have a lot of time to consider the subjects you want to choose for you Diploma.

About 20% of the PreDP studies will consist of optional study units.

- Languages (German, French, Spanish, Russian, Italian)
- Extra Swedish (for those who are aiming for the matriculation examination during the IB DP)
- Additional courses in natural sciences (in English)
- Lyseo specialities: theatre, work-life and entrepreneur studies (in Finnish)
- All the courses in Jyväskylä upper secondary schools (in Finnish)
- University courses for upper secondary students (EF, UEF)


APPLYING TO THE IB-DP IN 2024

JOINT APPLICATION 20.2.-19.3.2024

- Student selections will be based on grade point averages (min. 8,0)
- With the application a subject selection form will be filled (almost the same as with the general Finnish upper secondary schools) for pre-DP studies
- IB DP subjects will be selected at the end of the pre-DP year
- If no diploma from Finnish comprehensive school, Special consideration option can be implemented
